Graduation Program: British Columbia Certificate of Graduation (Dogwood Diploma)

In order to meet graduation requirements and be awarded a British Columbia Certificate of Graduation (Dogwood Diploma), students must earn a minimum of 80 credits and write all provincial assessments of numeracy and literacy. The 80 credits must include 52 credits for required courses and a minimum of 28 elective credits. The 28 elective credits may be from Ministry-Authorized or [Board/Authority Authorized \(BAA\) courses](#), post-secondary courses or [external credentials](#), but not Locally Developed courses. Students must also complete a minimum of 16 credits at the Grade 12 level, including a required Language Arts 12 course and Career Life Connections. At least 4 credits must have an Indigenous focus. ([Indigenous-Focused Graduation Requirements - Province of British Columbia](#)).

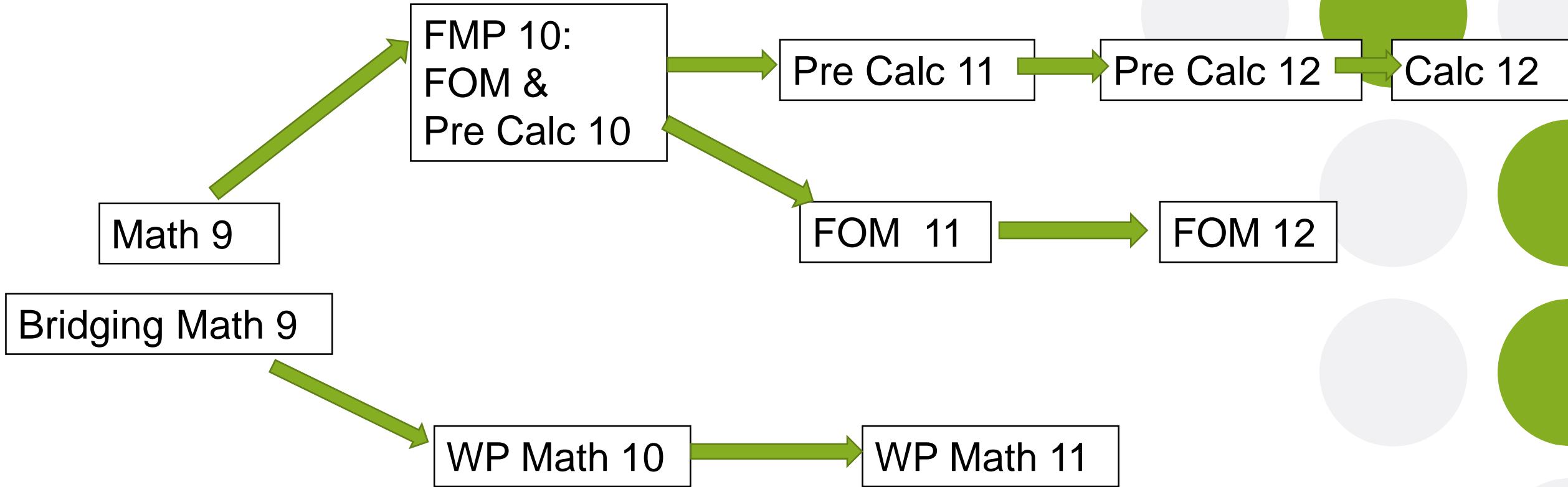
